Currently: we are seeking a candidate who would be available during the day to expand our career services and training program in the cities of Stanley and Thorp. This position is titled Employment Trainer, but may be best understood as a Job Coach. We work with individuals in need of support, typically because of the presence of a disability to learn and thrive in their jobs. The critical role of your position is not to complete the tasks for the individual, but to demonstrate, support and document as our "clients" complete their work tasks.

As this is a daytime position it may be perfect for a parent with a child in school. The expected hours are between 8 and 10 **hours** per week without evening hours nor work on the weekend.

Qualifications and Skills:

1. High School Diploma or equivalent.
2. At least two years experience of working with individuals with disabilities, or an equivalent work experience.
3. Successful completion of a pre-employment Dept. of Justice/Caregiver background check and DMV check.
4. A valid Wisconsin driver's license, appropriate/required coverage of auto insurance, and a reliable vehicle are required. Must have a clean driving record for the past 3 years.

Essential Duties and Responsibilities:

Your task is to support employment for each individual that may be a lasting fit for their skills and abilities. This is not a comprehensive job description; a full description will be provided at the submission of a resume.
